Explanation of Responses:

- 1. Represents the net issuance of 22,732 shares from the vesting of 43,724 restricted stock units from which the federal and state withholding due at the vesting of such restricted stock units was satisfied by the issuer withholding 20,992 shares. The reporting person relinquished the shares and the issuer cancelled the shares and returned them to treasury in exchange for remitting federal and state tax withholding obligations of the reporting person resulting from the vesting of restricted stock units. Shares withheld represent an exempt transaction pursuant to Section 16b-3(e). No shares were sold by the reporting person.
- 2. Represents the net issuance of 3,293 shares from the vesting of 6,335 restricted stock units from which the federal and state withholding due at the vesting of such restricted stock units was satisfied by the issuer withholding 3,042 shares. The reporting person relinquished the shares and the issuer cancelled the shares and returned them to treasury in exchange for remitting federal and state tax withholding obligations of the reporting person resulting from the vesting of restricted stock units. Shares withheld represent an exempt transaction pursuant to Section 16b-3(e). No shares were sold by the reporting person.
- 3. Represents the net issuance of 1,727 shares from the vesting of 3,322 restricted stock units from which the federal and state withholding due at the vesting of such restricted stock units was satisfied by the issuer withholding 1,595 shares. The reporting person relinquished the shares and the issuer cancelled the shares and returned them to treasury in exchange for remitting federal and state tax withholding obligations of the reporting person resulting from the vesting of restricted stock units. Shares withheld represent an exempt transaction pursuant to Section 16b-3(e). No shares were sold by the reporting person.
- 4. Represents the net issuance of 1,260 shares from the vesting of 2,425 restricted stock units from which the federal and state withholding due at the vesting of such restricted stock units was satisfied by the issuer withholding 1,165 shares. The reporting person relinquished the shares and the issuer cancelled the shares and returned them to treasury in exchange for remitting federal and state tax withholding obligations of the reporting person resulting from the vesting of restricted stock units. Shares withheld represent an exempt transaction pursuant to Section 16b-3(e). No shares were sold by the reporting person.
- 5. Represents the net issuance of 270 shares from the vesting of 520 restricted stock units from which the federal and state withholding due at the vesting of such restricted stock units was satisfied by the issuer withholding 250 shares. The reporting person relinquished the shares and the issuer cancelled the shares and returned them to treasury in exchange for remitting federal and state tax withholding obligations of the reporting person resulting from the vesting of restricted stock units. Shares withheld represent an exempt transaction pursuant to Section 16b-3(e). No shares were sold by the reporting person.
- 6. Each restricted stock unit is the economic equivalent of one share of Liquidity Services, Inc. Common Stock.
- 7. Represents the vesting of restricted stock.
- 8. Twenty-five percent of this restricted stock grant vested on October 1, 2016 and thereafter 1/4 of the restricted stock grant will vest on October 1 of each year for three years. In the event that Mr. Celaya's employment is terminated by the Company without cause or by Mr. Celaya for good reason within his first eighteen months of employment, 37.5 percent of this restricted stock grant will become vested as of the date of his termination. On the eighteen month anniversary of Mr. Celaya's start of employment, this acceleration provision will expire.
- 9. Twenty-five percent of this restricted stock grant vested on October 1, 2016 and thereafter 1/4th of the restricted stock grant will vest on October 1 of each year for three years.
- 10. These restricted stock units will vest, if at all, based on the Issuer's achievement of certain financial milestones.

TSR is calculated based on the change in a the issuer's stock price during the performance period, taking into account any dividends paid during that period, which are assumed to be reinvested in the stock.
- $18.\,15/48$ th of this option grant will vest on January 1, 2019 and thereafter 1/48th of the option grant will vest each month for thirty three months.
